

Pant sizes are based on your waist measurement in inches. To get the right size, grab a tape measure and follow the directions below. (One note: A soft tape measure, like tailors use, is most accurate.)

Waist

Determine how high or low on your waist or hip you like to wear your pants, and measure at this point. Keep the tape comfortably loose, and measure around the full circumference of your torso.



Inseam

Grab a pair of pants that fits you well, and lay it on a flat surface with the leg out straight. Measure from the crotch seam down to the ankle hem.

Helpful Hints

- Round up to the nearest quarter inch when specifying your desired inseam. For example, if your inseam measurement is 30 1/8", order the 30 1/4" inseam, not the 30" inseam.
- When measuring your waist, keep the tape parallel to the floor. Make sure to measure your body; don't measure on top of your clothes.
- Before making your final selections, check the 'Size' area on each product page to see if our Fit Specialists have any additional sizing tips.
- Pants will be hemmed uncuffed. The hems will be turned under, folded and sewn with a blind stitch.
