

FIND YOUR FIT: DRESS PANTS

Sizes are based on your waist measurement in inches. It's easy to get it right the first time—just grab a tape measure and follow the directions below. One quick note: A soft tape measure, like tailors use, is most accurate. Don't have one? Get resourceful with a length of twine and the tape measure you've got in the garage.



Waist

Determine how high on your hips you like to wear your pants, and measure at this point. Keep tape comfortably loose and measure around the full circumference of your torso.



Front Rise

Grab a pair of pants that fits you well and lay them on a flat surface. Measure from the top button of the waistband to the bottom of the crotch seam.



Back Rise

Measure from the back of the waistband to the bottom of the crotch seam.



Inseam

Measure from the crotch seam down to the hem.



Leg Opening

Measure the
circumference of the
bottom hem.
